### Gov. Whitmer Signs Bills Extending the Expiration of Driver's Licenses, State ID Cards, Vehicle Registrations to September 30<sup>th</sup>

On July 1, Governor Whitmer signed [Senate Bills 876-878](#), further extending the renewal dates for driver's licenses, CDLs, state ID cards and vehicle registrations. Among the extensions outlined in the legislation, those with driver's licenses or vehicle registrations expiring after March 1, would have until Sept. 30, 2020 to have them renewed.

This extension of drivers licenses will help Foreign Nationals retain authorization to drive in Michigan, despite expiration of their driver's license ("DL") as may have been impacted by slow processing of applications or extension requests with USCIS or the inability to secure an appointment at the Michigan SOS in order to have their DL renewed or reissued.
