COVID-19 EMERGENCY ORDER Gatherings & Face Mask Order

The Michigan Department of Health and Human Services issued another [Emergency Order](#) is effective from February 1st at 12:01 am until February 21st at 11:59 pm. It replaces the DHHS' January 13th Order. As far as changes from that Order, the State eliminated the low risk, moderate risk, and high risk categories of entertainment facilities. Instead, there is a single definition of entertainment and recreational facilities which is very broad.

The primary changes to the prior Order include:

1. Indoor gatherings are now permitted at non-residential venues, provided that no more than 10 persons from no more than 2 households attend
2. Gatherings at entertainment facilities, recreational facilities and food services establishments are permitted as of February 1st
3. Food service establishments, or the food service establishment portion of a multi-purpose venue, must close indoor dining between 10:00 pm and 4:00 am

The requirement to gathering data for contact tracing is revised to clearly apply to hair, nail, tanning, massage, traditional spa, tattoo, body art, piercing services or similar personal care facilities and to exercise facilities. In addition to in-home services, all dine-in food service establishments must maintain accurate records of the names and phone numbers of patrons and dates and times of entry for contact tracing.
